Annette Harned Berney, age 70, passed away Friday, December 17th, 2021 at her home in Parrottsville, Tennessee.

She was the daughter of Ed Harned and Anna Frances McCallister (Smith). She is preceded in death by her parents, father-in-law Fisher McAllister, brother Jimbo Harned and sister Barbara Cates of Little Rock, Arkansas, and uncle Charles Weaver Smith.

Retiring in 2008 to care for her mother, Annette kept very busy and in touch with a large circle of family and friends. Over the years, she served as caregiver for many family members, including her Uncle Herb Harned, her Uncle Fred Harned, and her father with cancer. 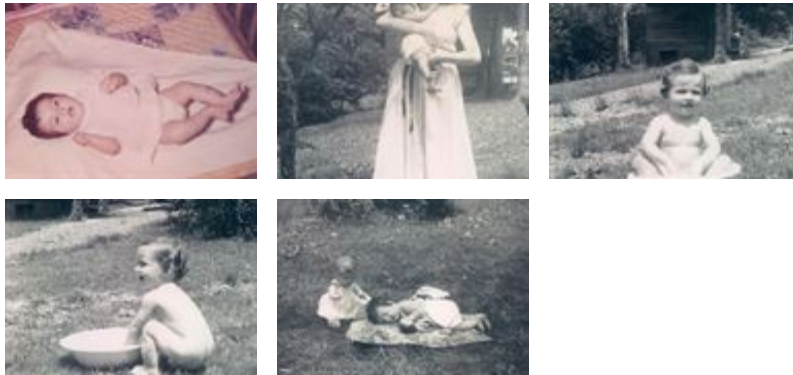

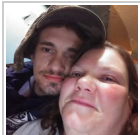
