Arthur Dean Williams age 90, beloved husband, father and grandfather, passed away Friday, February 21, 2025.

Dean was an active member of the First Baptist Church Newport for over 50 years. There he served on various committees, taught Sunday School Classes, was a deacon and later became Deacon Emeritus.

Dean was an active member of many organizations in the community during the course of his life. These included; being on the board of Cherokee Health Systems, Kiwanis Club member, and the Jaycees. Dean also served as a board member of Cocke County Baptist Hospital, and "Big Baptist" in Knoxville which later became Tennova Healthcare. During college at East Tennessee State University where he earned a Bachelor's degree in business, Dean was involved in ROTC. He later became an active Army first lieutenant and then did Army Reserve duty. Dean worked with Arapahoe Chemicals in Newport before relocating to Bush Brother's as their Human Resource Director. After retiring from Bush Brother's, Dean held the interim position of Economic Development Commissioner in Newport for seven years.

Dean is preceded in death by his parents, David Arthur and Bessie Hicks Williams; sister's Kate Huff and Marjorie Webb. Brothers, Ellis, Hollis and Dib Williams, son; Christian Dean Williams, and first wife Alice Thornton Williams. 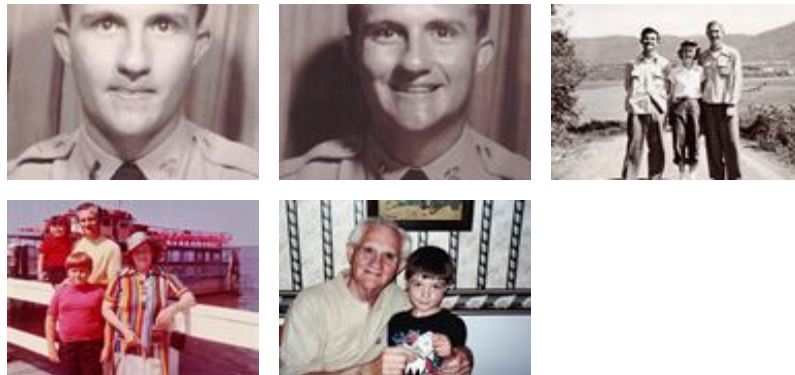

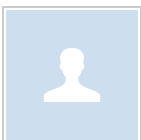

He was an inspiration and motivation to all. If you want to know how to be a good person, or a good Christian then watch Mr. Dean and do what he does, and you will be fine.

He was my friend, neighbor, Advisor, Mentor, Supporter, teacher and my second father. He filled my father's role after he passed. There is a giant hole in my heart that will be hard to fill. He would say to me have faith in GOD and never give up. I know he is with the LORD looking down on us. What i have written does not do Justice to one of the finest people I have ever known. I hope when I get to heaven, I can hear him say Come on in Good Neighbor.
