Her passion for her family and their success was evident to all who knew her. Even though Brenda's voice may be silent in the stands, her love, encouragement, temper, and fierce devotion for her family will continue through generations. 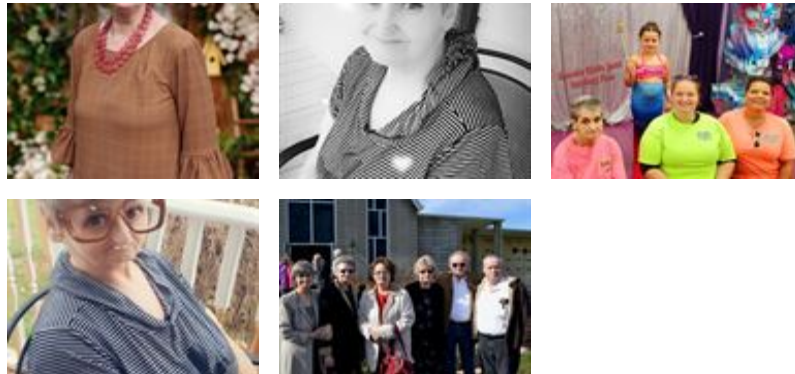
