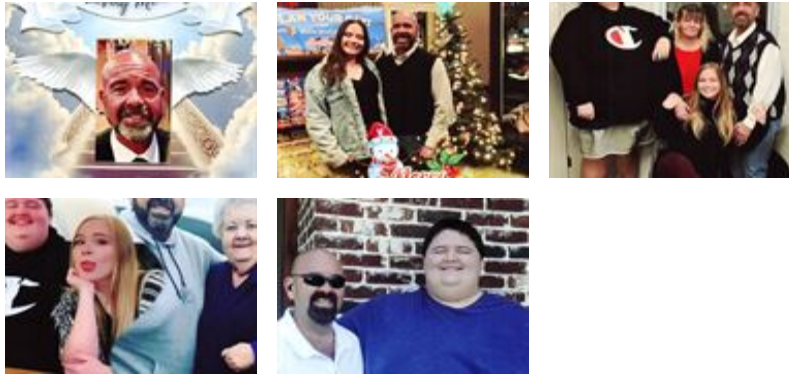

I hate having to speak of him in the past. This loss has made my soul cry. The sound of Clifford’s voice was gentle and full of love, always spoken with such respect and care for others. He often called me “sweetheart,” “darling,” or his favorite, “honey,” in the most grandfatherly way. He spoke to everyone with kindness, patience, and sincerity.

I will never forget when he had surgery and was in so much pain, yet he never slowed down. I remember telling him, “Clifford, you have to stop working so hard.” He would smile, chuckle, and say, “I know, honey.” That was who he was—selfless, resilient, and always putting others before himself.

Clifford never held grudges. If someone wronged him, he let it go almost immediately. He was truly an angel walking this earth, and anyone who knew him knows that he always went above and beyond to help others.

One of my favorite memories is the last time we spoke. My partner offered him a water, and I joked, “Clifford doesn’t drink water.” Without missing a beat, Clifford shared a joke about telling his doctor he drinks two to three cubes of water a day. That was Clifford—always making light of a moment, always trying to bring joy and laughter to those around him.

Clifford held immense love for his wife, his children, and his entire family. He was especially proud of his beloved UT football team and was always repping them—whether it was his orange cup filled with

ice, a sticker on his van, or something he was wearing.

Clifford taught me how to drive while I was extremely scared—a core memory for me. He was endlessly patient and reassuring, always calm and steady. He would say, “Honey, I promise, it isn’t hard. You’ll be good at it in no time.” Had it not been for his constant encouragement, I wouldn’t have believed in myself the way I did then.

He always had the most encouraging words, the most interesting stories, and never failed to say something funny. Being around Clifford meant feeling supported, loved, and uplifted.

There are truly no words to express how great of a person Clifford was or what he meant to everyone who had the privilege of knowing him. I pray that God covers his family and friends during this painful time. To have known and loved Clifford was a blessing—losing him is heartbreaking
