During her twenty-seven years of teaching, Debbie poured her heart into her

students. Debbie showed every student kindness, encouragement, and most of all taught them to believe in themselves. Her classroom was a haven for all students.

Many students gained not only knowledge but also self-confidence, knowing they could accomplish their goals. Above all, Debbie's life was anchored in her unwavering faith. Debbie placed her trust and faith in Jesus Christ.

Raised in church, she continued to serve in many capacities. One of her greatest gifts to the church her musical talent was a gift from God, Debbie used it to glorify Him. Debbie was a prayer warrior; she was often called to pray for others. Her walk with the Lord was evident in everything she did, from her words and actions to her boundless love. 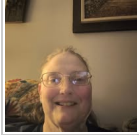
