Delmer C. Taylor, 100, passed away at The Waters of Johnson City on Friday, July 5, 2019. He was born in Cocke County, Tennessee on May 21, 1919 to Al and Farrie Allen Taylor. Delmer lived in Newport for 85 years before moving to Jonesborough, Tennessee in 2004. He was a War World II Army Veteran. Delmer was a well-known brick mason in Newport and later operated a used car lot. He was married to Judith McNabb Taylor for 67 years prior to her death in 2011. Delmer loved to play the guitar and he and Judith loved to sing in their church. They lived in the Carson Springs community and were members of Grace Baptist Church, Newport.
