Edward Terry Rowekamp, 82, of Newport, Tennessee passed away peacefully on April 26, 2026.

Terry was born on July 30, 1943 in Cincinnati Ohio to Edward and Ruth Rowekamp. After graduating from Elder High School he graduated with a Bachelor's of Science degree from the University of Cincinnati in 1965.

He obtained his Master's Degree in Petroleum Geology from the University of Colorado in Boulder.
