



Elizabeth Woodson Marston

April 17, 1921 - November 4, 2006

Nannie Elizabeth Woodson Marston, age 85, widowed housewife, died at her home with family members present on Saturday, November 4, 2006, following a long illness with Alzheimers.

She was born April 17, 1921, in Oldtown, Cocke County Tennessee, to the late J.W. "Hervey and Ida O'Dell Woodson. She united in marriage with L.B. "Buck" Marston on August 6, 1949 in Providence Forge, Virginia and lived there until his death after a career with the Virginia State Police.

Mrs. Marston was a life member of the William Cocke Chapter and the Betsy Ross Chapter of Daughters of the American Revolution and the Martha Dandridge Woman's Club, New Kent, Virginia.

Mrs. Marston is survived by several nieces and nephews, mentioned for brevity are Polly Webb; Nile Woodson and Nease Woodson of Newport and Myra Fowler of Philipsburg, Pennsylvania and Shane Woodson of Jonesborough, Tennessee. In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by an infant daughter Jean Elizabeth Sutton. Additionally four brothers, Robert, Ryland, Charles, and Gayden have preceded Mrs. Marston.

In keeping with Mrs. Marston's wishes, her remains have been cremated and will be returned to the graveside of her husband at St. Peter's Parish Episcopal Church in New Kent, Virginia.
