Eugene Huff, age 88 born May 25, 1932, passed away peacefully at his Newport, TN home on Wednesday, July 15, 2020 with his beloved family and his long-time pal, "TEBOW- the best dog he has ever had!" as he often whispered to him.

He was an Air Force Veteran who served during the Korean War.

Eugene had been battling with Alzheimer's for a long time now and the disease finally led to his passing. He was under UT Hospice care since May of 2020 with Charles Allen as his nurse who showed so much compassion and concern for him and his family.
