Frances Shumaker Rhyne of Newport was born May 12, 1923 in Raleigh NC to Ross E Shumaker and Mozelle W Shumaker. She died January 31, 2023 in Nashville. She was the wife of the late Charles Thomas Rhyne Jr. (1922-1997). She is survived by her two daughters and son Terry Mullins of Louisville, Sally Pierce of Nashville and Tom Rhyne of Rockmart, GA. She is grandmother to eight and great grandmother to 18. She is also survived by her youngest sister Elaine, of Baltimore, Maryland. Her older brother James, older sister Peggy and twin sister Betsy pre-deceased her.

Frances married Charles Rhyne March 17, 1943 and move to live in Newport 1944. Their home, on College Street was built in 1950 and remained her home until May, 2022 when she moved to live with her daughter Sally in Nashville. She was a member of First United Methodist Church, an active member of Century Club and the Gardening Club of Newport. It was her stitched quilt squares for the Century Club design that was included in the Tennessee state Quilt and was chosen as the square for the National quilt that is at the Smithsonian Institute. She loved and raised Orchids many years. She was known to supply orchids to local florists for local events.
