Hazel Ruth Jarnigan, 79, died as peacefully as she had lived on February 10, 2010.

Hazel was the last surviving child of Phil & Alice Jarnigan, the 7th of 9 children. In her last years, she continued to minister to many others through a Birthday Ministry. She would call her many friends, acquaintances, former co-workers and family members each year on their birthday just to show someone remembered them.
