James David Renner, age 73 of Parrottsville, passed away Sunday, September 1, 2019 at Turkey Creek Medical Center in Knoxville. He was a member of Bethel Baptist Church in Parrottsville. James was a 1964 graduate of Parrottsville High School and received his Educational Specialist Degree from East Tennessee State University. He began his 30 year teaching career at Bridgeport Elementary School where he also coached the boy's basketball team. He also taught at Parrottsville High School and Edgemont Elementary and coached football at Parrottsville prior to his retirement. He was an avid outdoorsman and especially enjoyed deer hunting. He was also a former member of the Cocke County Legislative Body (CLB). He was preceded in death by his father U.L. Renner. 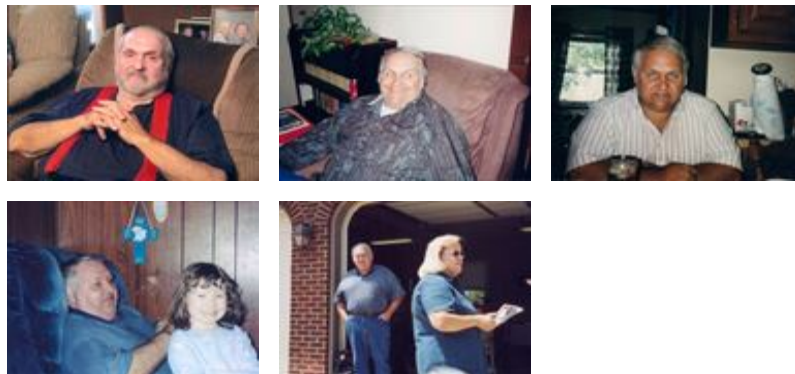
