Jan Austin Covington, age 69 of Newport, passed away Saturday, January 24, 2026.

Jan was a devoted wife, sister, and friend. She was a charter member of New Life Baptist Church. She was a retired school teacher spending her whole career of 32 years with over 960 students at Edgemont Elementary School. Her favorite grade to teach was the 3rd grade.

She loved Bible School and cross stitching. She gave away many quilts, especially to newborn babies. She was a lifelong Cocke County resident. She was preceded in death by her parents Hugh and Marie Austin; brother Charles Austin; and nephew Jonathan Austin.
