Kenneth Howard Reed, age 93, of Parrottsville, passed away Sunday, June 23, 2024.

He was a loving father, uncle and grandfather. He was born to Royd and Roxie Reed on June 22, 1931. He was a member of Bethel Baptist Church. He was a veteran of the United States Army Airborne Division. He served during the Korean War and was a Communications Specialist while enlisted.
