



Kenneth Stokely

February 9, 1926 - April 15, 2011

Mr. Kenneth Stokely, age 85, departed this earthly realm on Friday, April 15, 2011 at Anderson Mill Health and Rehabilitation Center in Austell, GA.

Kenneth accepted Christ at an early age and was a dedicated member of Allen's Chapel Missionary Baptist Church. He served as a Deacon for forty plus years. He was Chairman of Deacon Board, Sunday School Superintendent, President of Senior Choir and Laymen. He was very active in the Bethel District Association (Region 1 Vice-President of Congress, President of Laymen, Vice-President of Brotherhood) as well as in the Tennessee State Convention. He was a member of the Star of The East Masonic Lodge No. 353, where he held the rank of 33rd degree and a member of the Shriners. He retired after 40 plus years from Wood Products Inc. Kenneth was faithfully active in the Coker County Senior Citizens and served two separate terms with the Coker County Farm Services Agency for a total of 10 years.

He was preceded in death by his loving wife of fifty-seven years, Judia Mae Hampton Stokely; his Parents Mr. & Mrs. Joseph (Lelia) Stokely; Sisters, Mary and Martha; Brothers, Hubert and Frederick (Jerlyne).
