Lloyd Verlin Ball, age 78, of Newport, passed away Sunday, Oct. 5, 2008 in Newport.

A 30 year veteran of the U S Marine Corps , he served in the Korean War and was involved in the assault and seizure of Inchon, Korea; capture and securing of Seoul, Korea; combat operations, against North Korean Forces; Wonsan-Hungnam-Chosin Campaign, North Korea; and operations against enemy forces in South and Central Korea. Some of his awards include Bronze Star with Combat "V", PUC w/ 1 star, GCMed, Korean Service Medal w/3 stars, and UN Ribbon. He was owner and operator of Lloyds Bar for 38 years. He was preceded in death by his wife, Georgia Ball; father, Ira Ball, mother, Belle Ball, brothers, Samuel Ball and Travis Ball and wife Ruth, nephew Billy Ribble and special friend Gordon Turner.
