Lucile Wilson Cureton, of Newport, was born June 21, 1918, married J. M. Cureton on June 20, 1945, and died on Tuesday, December 16, 2014. She was a member of First Baptist Church, where she has served as Sunday School Teacher, Adult Sunday School Director, and various offices in the WMU and Baptist Training Union.

She was a member of Alpha Omega Chapter of Delta Kappa Gamma, GFWC Newport William Cocke Chapter of National Daughters of American Revolution (DAR) Cocke County Retired Teachers Association and Farm Bureau Women.

She attended Newport Grammar School, Cocke County High School graduating as Salutatorian of her class in 1936. Attended Maryville College for two years, took night classes from U T and graduated from Carson-Newman College in 1957 and taught school for 41 years.
