She slipped peacefully from this life to Heaven during the early hours of October 26, 2017. The Lord decided His faithful servant had endured enough after a heartbreaking illness. She is now in her eternal home and rejoicing with her mother, Amanda Tidwell Page; her mother-in-law, Maxie Charlotte Terry; her father-in-law, Cecil Benjamin Parker; and other relatives.

She and Wayne came to Newport, TN in 1980 when Wayne purchased and became the sole proprietor and pharmacist of Newport Drug Store, into which they both poured heart and soul to make a
