Mary Dee Ottinger, age 94, of Salem Road, Parrottsville, passed away Wednesday, July 9, 2014 at Holston Valley Medical Center. Mary Dee was born, July 6, 1920, in Parrottsville. She was a retired teacher and belonged to the Cocke County Retired Teachers Association. She taught 25 years at Parrottsville High School and 5 years at the new Parrottsville Elementary School.
