Solomon C. Black, of Newport, better known as S.C. departed this life on Sunday, July 20, 2014 at the age of 98 at Wellington Place where he had made his home for the past several years.

S.C. was a Pearl Harbor survivor. He served as an M-1 rifle expert and heavy truck driver during his military service. He was stationed at Schofield barracks in Hawaii when the infamous attack occurred. He was awarded the Asiatic Pacific Theater Ribbon with one Bronze Star and an American Defense Service Ribbon with one Bronze Star for his service.

He was a life time member of the American Legion Post 41 and VFW.

S.C., was a member of Dutch Bottoms Baptist Church and attended faithfully until his health prevented him from attending.
