Shell Mack Clevenger, aged 60, died on July 30, 2018 at his home in Lawrenceville, Ga. Shell was born June 17, 1958 in Knoxville Tennessee. He graduated from South High in Knoxville (1976.) Shell then went into the U.S. Army, serving in Army Intelligence (ASA) and in the 82nd Airborne Division. After the Army, he graduated from Pellissippi State Community College, attended the University of Tennessee, and then began working for IBM where he held a number of patents. In recent years, up to his death, he worked as a Solutions Architect for Corus 360, a software company in Atlanta. He supported and volunteered for a number of veteran's causes. Shell was beloved by family and friends. Always ready with good cheer and a smile, he was there for everyone at the drop of a hat, in good times or bad. In addition, he freely offered his high-level computer expertise to all of us whenever we needed it. He was an avid Vols fan and loved the mountains of Tennessee.
