Our families moved to White Pine together from Ettowah in 1963 as our fathers both worked for Daniels Construction company at the American Enka plant. 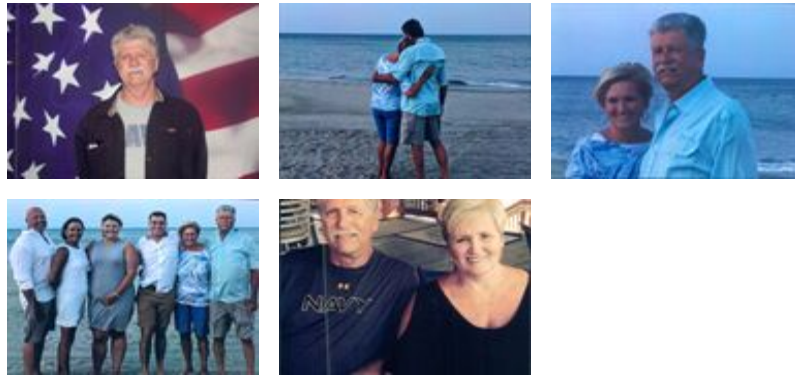
