Stephen Tanner Smith age 51 of Oak Ridge, TN formerly of Morristown died on Tuesday Sept 4, 2012 after experiencing a sudden illness. He was of the Catholic faith.

Smith was born in Morristown in 1961. He was an active member of Boy Scout Troop 91, became an Eagle Scout and assistant Scout Master. He was a member of a national champion Native American dancing troupe. He graduated from Morristown Hamblen High School West in 1979. He received his B.S.

He went on to become a college professor, teaching at several community colleges in East Tennessee, including Walters State, Roane State, Cleveland State and Hiwassee College.
