We immediately became friends when we both lived at Hess Hall and I was starting my freshman year at UT. He was the ring leader of our dorm and definitely the funnest guy to be around. There is no other way to say it better -- we had a blast! Our friendship took us on ski trips to Boone, back to his home town of Newport to meet his family and one infamous Rush concert in Atlanta where we had an odd encounter with Sinead O'Connor sitting next to us on the Marta train at the airport. We did not even know it was her until she got off and another passenger told us who we had been speaking with. Unbeknownst to us, she had also played a concert in Atlanta that night. I still remember Tommy coming home from the hospital after barely surviving the brown recluse spider bite. I still tell that story today--

I have one funny moment i want to share. We were finishing our lunch in Atlanta after attending a concert the night before and Tommy went to the bathroom . While he was away from the table, I convinced our waitress to play a prank on him that he had just eaten a bad fish that had made two other people in the restaurant very ill. She played it so well and proceeded to ask Tommy if he was feeling Ok. I will never forget Tommy touching his cheek with the back of his hand and saying " now that I think about it..I am feeling flushed". She then told Tommy he probably needed to get to the hospital. He looked like he had seen a ghost and then he saw us struggling to contain our laughter... and then he was ready to kill me lol.

Tommy, I miss those times. You were one of those people that could befriend anyone anywhere. I will always cherish the memories, the laughs, the trips, the good times and even the life lessons. I came to Knoxville from Memphis and had no clue about the culture of East Tennessee and you were one great tour guide! Your words always carried so much conviction that as I write this it feels like you are here in the same room.

I look forward to seeing you again one day brother. Sleep well..
