Una Merle Gay Bell went to be with her Lord and Savior Jesus Christ on February 7, 2017, at her home. Una was born in Pittsfield, Massachusetts on August 5, 1933. After high school, Una served honorably as a Tech Sergeant in the United States Air Force where she worked as a weather observer. She met an Air Policeman by the name of Dallas Frank Bell whom she married in Puerto Rico on December 7, 1955. Una earned her Associate of Arts from North Greenville University, Bachelor of Arts from Carson-Newman University, and Master of Arts from East Tennessee State University.
