William Frederick Clark was born in the Rankin Community on October 27, 1936, passed away Wednesday, June 22, 2022.

His family lived in Cleveland, Ohio in the early forties.

They returned to Newport to live where Fred graduated from Coker County High School in 1955 (and from Knoxville Business College in 1956).

Fred and Mary Ann McAndrew were married on June 23, 1960. They lived in Orlando, Florida for fifteen years, returning to Newport and the mountains in 1976.

Fred was a member of the First Baptist Church where he very much loved his Sunday School class. During his working years, he was employed in banking and insurance and the state employment office. You most often knew him as he drove in the community in the orange Volunteer truck.

He was preceded in death by his father and mother, William Rex and Aurelia Tittle Clark, and his sister, Norma Lou Clark Miller.

He is survived by his wife of sixty-two years (less one day), Mary Ann McAndrew Clark, son, William Rex Clark, grandchildren, Kaylee D. Clark, Carly Bowen Garcia (Angel Garcia) (Fort Sill Oklahoma), and Eowyn Ithilia Clark. He has one great-grandson Angel Garcia, Jr. Also surviving are his brother-in-law, Clarence Miller and nephews Clark and Bruce Miller.
